



Northwest Anthropological Conference 2022 Call for Abstracts

The 75th Northwest Anthropological Conference will be held online 9-12 March 2022. Registration is free, thanks to the support of the Northwest Anthropological Association and 2022 sponsors. The conference will be hosted on the Socio event platform.

The first NWAC was hosted in 1948 at Reed College, chaired by Luther Cressman, and was attended by 49 people. In 2021, over 750 people registered from around the world to attend our first virtual conference. This year, we ask Northwest anthropologists to reflect on the 75-year history of NWAC and the history of Anthropology in the Northwest.
