OF THE NORTHWEST ANTHROPOLOGICAL CONFERENCE, 1954

In the original compilation of the first twenty meetings of the Northwest Anthropological Conference, the seventh annual meeting at Vancouver in 1954 was omitted because no program could be found (Sprague 1958). Through the kindness of David H. French who was on leave from Reed College at the time of the initial inquiry, a program of the seventh meeting is now available. This program was printed as a joint program with the now defunct Western States Branch, American Anthropological Association and may have been filed under that organization in many personal files, thus explaining the rarity of this item.
